Fire Department

Last week, Jackson Fire and EMS personnel responded to 16 medical calls and three (3) fire calls. All three (3) fire calls were canceled en route.

Monday night’s training this week involved activities relating to water tender apparatus driving, the recruit academy, and the ambulance committee. Staff also dedicated time this week preparing several grant submittals for items including a hose rolling rack and pagers.

The Hickory Lane Splash Pad is now open every day through Labor Day from 10:00 AM – 7:00 PM. Ice cream treats are for sale 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM, Monday-Friday (weather permitting).

Other Jackson Community Center (JCC) programming updates include: The West Bend Mobile Library was on-site this week for patrons to check out books and other media. The Pickleball summer schedule has started, with sessions on Mondays from 8:30 AM - Noon, Tuesdays from 8:30 AM - 10:30 AM, Wednesdays from 5:00 PM – 8:00 PM, Thursdays from 5:15 PM - 7:15 PM, and Fridays from 8:30 AM - Noon. On Tuesday, ATI Physical Therapy of West Bend completed free physical assessments for seniors and patrons. The Germantown Library started their Reading Book Club and weekly Friday Fun Days at Hickory Lane Park. The JCC Spring Youth Dance Recital will take place at Action in Jackson on Saturday, June 11th, at 10:30 AM.

Building Inspection

Foundations for two (2) additional homes in the Morning Meadows subdivision were completed this week. Occupancy was granted for Ernisse Distributors, LLC located at W225N16720 Cedar Park Court, where the company will operate a warehouse and distribution center for their family-owned beverage business. Several property maintenance complaints relating to unkempt lawns were received this week, with Notice of Violations being issued to each property owner.

Public Works

The Street and Parks Department Crew continued with the curbside yard waste bag collection and chipping program this week. The chipper has been repaired and back in service and chipping will continue until all has been completed. Staff also dedicated time to street sign replacement, mowing, and preparing Jackson Park for Action in Jackson.

The Jackson Water Utility Crew continued with locates and meter changeouts this week. We completed 180 Diggers Hotline locates for the month of May. The interview process has begun for the Full-Time Water Operator position. There is also the potentiality of filling the vacant Streets and Parks laborer position with this pool of applicants.

The Wastewater Treatment Plant Crew continued with completing work orders, cleaning, and general maintenance this week, which included televising another seven (7) sanitary laterals and maintaining the raw sewage pumps. Staff met with Town & Country Engineering regarding a proposed facility amendment plan. The purpose of the meeting was to review and revise the first four (4) chapters of the plan, which will be forwarded to the DNR for approval. Once the DNR approval is granted, we can proceed with the next chapters of the plan.

The Village Engineer discussed items requiring completion with the contractor for the Willow Ridge Reconstruction Project, with landscaping being the priority. Also, discussion continues with Cable Comm for landscaping corrections relating to the Midwest Fiber Network's "Fiber to the Home" project.

Administration

Treasurer Smith joined an Ehlers webinar on "Tax Increment District Closure", which covered the key questions to remember before a TID closing. She also participated in an Employee Trust Funds (ETF) local update virtual meeting regarding 2023 health and pharmacy benefit changes, open enrollment key dates, supplemental insurance overview (dental, vision & accident), local life insurance, termination of employment checklist, and a Well Wisconsin overview.

Community Notification

Special Bulletin Notification - Sex Offender Release

Date: Thursday, June 9, 2022

The Jackson Police Department is releasing the following information pursuant to WI Statute 301.46(2m) which authorizes law enforcement agencies to inform the public of a sex offender's release when, in the discretion of the agency, the release of information will enhance public safety, awareness and protection. The individual who appears on this notification has been convicted of a sex offense.

Vincent C. Jablonski of N161W19504 Forest View Drive, Jackson will be released from prison on June 14, 2022. Vincent Jablonski was convicted of four counts of possession of child pornography in 2019. Vincent Jablonski will be on parole until 2026. He will be monitored closely by WI-DOC Division of Community Corrections. Vincent Jablonski will have numerous rules and restrictions to follow including wearing a live tracking GPS unit. Vincent Jablonski resided at this address prior to his conviction, and prior to the establishment of the Village of Jackson Sex Offender Residency Ordinance.

This sex offender has served the prison sentence imposed on him by the courts. He is NOT wanted by law enforcement at this time. This notification is not intended to increase fear, but rather it is our belief that an informed public is a safer public.

Sex offenders have always lived in our communities; but it was not until the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law was enacted that law enforcement was able to share this information with the community. More information can be located at <https://appsdoc.wi.gov/public/faq>

Additional Sex Offender Information: As of 06/01/22, there are 26,161 registrants required to register with the State of Wisconsin, of them, 5,650 are incarcerated, 6,334 are on supervision, and 14,177 are terminated (not on supervision).
