Public Works

The Jackson Water Utility continues the hiring process for two (2) open positions. Three (3) temporary hydrant water meters were installed at the new Municipal Complex Building site to water the newly planted landscaping.

The Street and Parks Department Crew continues with lawn maintenance, tree trimming, cold patching asphalt, and removal of dead trees. At Hickory Lane Park, a bench was installed near the sand next to the playground. We encourage you to stop in at the Public Works Office to get a Yard Waste Site card. Access cards can be obtained from 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM at our Public Works Office located at W194 N16660 Eagle Drive.

At the Wastewater Treatment Plant, daily operations continue to include shop cleaning and general maintenance. The roof project that was started last month has been completed. The Jackson Utility will be partnering with local Sewer Utilities and Washington County to be part of an information booth at the Washington County Fair, July 20th – July 25th. We look forward to seeing you there!

Building Inspection

This week, a total of 42 permits were issued between Tuesday and Thursday, despite the short holiday week. Inspection volume was extremely heavy this week. Plan review and permits were issued for two (2) additional homes in the Morning Meadows Subdivision. Staff participated in a webinar, hosted by the Wisconsin Department of Safety & Professional Services, relating to new on-line requirements for permit reporting.

Clerk

The annual Liquor Licensing report was filed with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue. The Wisconsin Elections Commission has mailed postcards to residents who were identified as potentially moving. Voters who receive the postcard and have moved within the State may choose to register online, by mail, or at the Clerk's Office. Voters who have not moved, may affirm the address on their voter registration by signing and returning the postcard to the Clerk.

Treasurer

The Village received the second quarter General Transportation Aids from the State of Wisconsin in the amount of \$78,651.54. The Village also received the 2022 WRS rates from the State; the rate for General Employees is 13% and the rate for Protective with Social Security Employees is 18.5%. The Income Continuation Insurance premium holiday is continuing into 2022 for local participants.


20th ANNIVERSARY 9/11 SHIRTS


