2023 Pet Licensing Information

All dogs and cats five (5) months of age or older must be licensed by January 1st. Rabies vaccine certificates are required before a license may be issued. There will be a \$10.00 late fee for each pet not licensed by March 31st, 2023.

Pet licensing fees are:

Dogs: \$10 Spayed/Neutered \$15-Unaltered
Cats: \$7 Spayed/Neutered \$10-Unaltered



Adopt-A-Hydrant

The Jackson Fire Department requests that during the winter months, please keep the fire hydrant near your home clear of snow and ice. Searching for that hydrant buried in snow can take valuable time away from fighting a fire. For questions or concerns, please call 262-677-3811.

Keep Sidewalks Clear

Property owners are reminded to keep all public sidewalks completely clear of snow and ice, along the full width and length of the sidewalk. Sidewalks must be cleared within 24 hours after snow or ice ceases to fall.



Failure to maintain sidewalks in a clear and safe manner may result in the issuance of a municipal citation.

Heater Safety

Heating equipment is the leading cause of fires in U.S. homes. Each year, fire departments respond to over 52,000 fires involving heating equipment, which includes wood-burning fireplaces, ovens and space-heaters. Reports indicate that more than 1/2 of all home heating fires occur in the months of December, January, and February. Some safety tips to consider are:

- Keeping any combustibles at least three (3) feet away from heating equipment
- Never use the oven or stove to heat your home
- Do not use grills intended for outdoor use or kerosene/propane heaters inside your home
- Have heating equipment and chimneys professionally cleaned and inspected each year
- Do not leave space heaters unattended

From the Desk of the Village President . . .

Happy New Year!

Best wishes to all of you who contribute to making the Village of Jackson the best it can be!

The Village Board continues to consider ways to best utilize the property around the municipal building on Main Street for the long-term growth of the Village. Commercial and residential projects that will make meaningful contributions to the tax increment district are being considered, with planning assistance and input from both private and public entities. A second Public Information Meeting for the residential development is anticipated to occur in April or May.

Work on the Maple Fields Subdivision, located south of Sherman Road and west of Maple Road, continues to take shape, with many of the utilities in place for phase one building to begin.

At the same time, the Morning Meadows Subdivision, located north of Sherman Road and east of County Highway P, continues with early phases quickly nearing completion.

However, since the Village of Germantown passed a referendum in favor of providing water to an industrial development in Richfield, that opportunity is no longer available to the Village of Jackson. There was the possibility of considering whether or not it is in the best interest of the Village of Jackson to sell water to the Village of Richfield.

Preparations continue for many aspects of improvement in the Village, as several projects loom in the coming years. Washington County plans to improve County Highway P in 2024, the State of Wisconsin plans to improve State Highway 60 in 2024, and Village Engineering and the Village Board of Public Works are working together on plans to install a round-about at the intersection of State Highway 60 and Eagle Drive.

In addition, Staff and the Village Board of Public Works are considering the best way to augment and improve systems at the Wastewater Treatment Plant to comply with the latest requirements of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.

As the Spring Election nears, please take the time and make the effort to become informed on the issues we are facing as a Village, and which Village candidates might be best suited to serve.

Thank you to all the Village employees and volunteers for your interest in, and service to, our great community!

Dog License Fees: Unaltered \$15; Neutered/Spayed \$10.

Cat License Fees: Unaltered \$10; Neutered/Spayed \$7.

(After March 31, 2023, there is an additional \$10 late fee per license.)

The West Bend School District/Jackson Parks & Recreation 4K Enrollment for 2023-24 Begins January 30, 2023

The West Bend School District community-based 4K Program is an optional program offered at no cost to families who live in the West Bend School District (WBSD) attendance area. The Jackson Parks & Recreation Department is a 4K partner that offers the 4K and supported 3K at the Jackson Area Community Center. The program is taught by certified teachers that use play to promote early reading, math skills, language development, and social/emotional growth through play. Children in the WBSD who are at least four years of age on or before September 1, 2023, are eligible to enroll in the WBSD 4K program. Enrollment will start on January 30, 2023 and will only be online. **Germantown School District children may be eligible to open enroll into a Jackson 4K site in 2023**, complete the open enrollment forms on the WBSD site. **There will be a Virtual WBSD 4K Informational Parent Meeting Thursday, January 12, 2023.**
