Village Project Updates

Parks—The Jackson Park courts are in the midst of conversion from 2 basketball hoops and 4 tennis courts to now include 4 pickleball courts, 3 basketball hoops, 1 tennis court that can be utilized for pickleball and 1 designated tennis court. The project is currently on schedule to finish up by Labor Day weekend.

Utilities—The Main Street utility upgrade project has concluded. Work will commence along the right of way on CTH P south of Main Street for looping of sewer and water mains. Work is expected to be completed by October. There will also be sidewalk poured on the north side of Highland Road in August.

Main Street— Work will commence in July to replace the current street lights with new poles and fixtures. There will be a reduction from 68 light poles to just 36. The new fixtures will be more energy efficient with illumination levels consistent with the current lighting plan. Work is expected to be completed in the Fall. During replacement of the poles there will not be flags displayed, but we look forward to displaying them proudly next summer when the pole installation is completed. The next edition of the Jackson Quarterly will also host an update for the 2024 WisDOT resurfacing of Main Street from CTH P to Eagle Drive and construction of a roundabout at Eagle Drive.

Oaks of Jackson Development—The Village is developing a 20 acre property south of Spruce Street and Ridgeway Drive. Significant completion of infrastructure and start of home construction is expected in October. This phase of work includes construction of 40 homes and 8 side by side condo units, all to be owner occupied.

Jackson Police Department National Night Out

The 2023 JPD National Night Out will be held at Hickory Lane Park on Tuesday, August 1st, from 5:00PM - 8:00PM. The event will include DNR archery range, food trucks, Free raffles and several vendors including Washington County Humane Society. We hope to see you there.

Public Facility Use




The second installment of the 2022 property taxes shall be made payable and mailed to the Washington County Treasurer. Questions? Call (262) 335-4324.

Please visit the Building Inspection Department Located at W194 N16660 Eagle Dr, 7:30 AM - 4:00 PM. The office is open weekdays excluding Holidays. The dropbox is available for after-hours submittals.

If you have recently completed a project, such as remodeling, HVAC replacement, electrical service upgrades, built a shed or fence, replacement of windows/roof/siding, or any other project that may have required a permit, a Final Inspection is required. Inspections help to protect you, your family, and your property against work defects and building, plumbing, electric and HVAC code deficiencies.

From the Desk of the Village President . . .

Village of Jackson Residents,

Welcome to my first quarterly newsletter article since being elected Village President in April. I am honored to have been chosen by you, the residents of the Village of Jackson, to help lead the Village forward.

First off, I would like to take a moment to thank outgoing Village President Mike Schwab for his years of service to the Village. Mike served the Village of Jackson residents for many years, with the last 8 years as Village President. I have learned many things from Mr. Schwab over the years and I have so much respect for him and the service he provided to us here in Jackson. He leaves big shoes to fill. I hope I can rise to the challenge and be as good of a leader as he was for our Village.

There are so many great things going on in our Village that the list would be long if I listed them all so I will just hit some of the highlights. Some of the items include the completion of the utility upgrades along Hwy 60, the reconstruction of the pickleball/tennis/basketball court project going on in Jackson Park, the Sysco expansion is in full swing, we are evaluating the possibility of expanding the Jackson Community Center, the roads and utilities are being installed in the Oaks of Jackson development, homes have started to pop up in the Maple Fields subdivision, and Chief Vossekuil at the Police Department has launched an initiative to fundraise enough money to bring a K9 Unit back to the Jackson Police Department.

In closing, I would just like to reiterate something that I've brought up in all the campaigns that I've run for Village office. I will always make decisions for the Village that I believe are in the best interest of the Village as a whole. I know there will be some things that come up that not everyone will agree with. Jackson Community Center Expansion - Phase I design & estimates were approved in Spring. Phase II for bids and construction are still in the works.


Hasmer Lake Park Master Plan - The Master Plan was approved in Spring. Staff is currently working with the DNR for potential future development.






