MUNICIPAL COMPLEX NEARS COMPLETION!

After 13 months of construction and just a few more to go, the Municipal Complex has achieved 75% completion. The General Contractor of the facility, Mike Koenig Construction, is working steadily to complete the construction of the building by September 17, 2021.

After September, Staff will focus on the installation of the facility's Security Camera System, Door Access Control System, Audio/Video technologies, Radio Systems, and Phone Systems. Once these systems are installed and final occupancy inspections of the building are complete, it is the intention of Staff to incorporate a phased move into the facility. Moving will begin with the Jackson Fire Department, followed by the Jackson Police Department, and lastly the Village Hall Administrative Staff will be settled in by mid-October. All three (3) departments will provide the community with updates as "moving days" are selected, to ensure members of the public can be served at the current locations before we are fully operational at the Municipal Complex.

at villageofjackson.com and selecting "Publications" to find our weekly edition of the "Jackson Weekly Update". All mail for the Village will continue to be received at P.O. Box 637.

In addition to adding the Municipal Complex to this site, two (2) streets have been extended — Spruce Street east to Eagle Drive and Ridgeway Drive south to the new Spruce Street extension. These roadways will not only serve as access points to the Municipal Complex, but also to future businesses and residential units planned for the remaining sites surrounding the Municipal Complex.

WATER MAIN FLUSHING **OCTOBER 18th—22nd**

The Jackson Water Utility will be flushing the entire water system one week earlier than normal—from Monday, October 18th to Friday, October 22nd between 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM.

Flushing is performed to improve the quality of your water service. You may experience a temporary interruption in service. If your service is off for more than thirty minutes, please call the Utility office at: 262-677-0707.

Use the Automatic Payment Plan to pay your Sewer and Water bill to avoid late fees.

POOL SAFETY

Did you know drowning is the #1 leading cause of injury-related death among children ages 1-4? During the hot summer months, many of us enjoy a dip in the water to cool off. If you or your child is in or near a pool, lake, or any large body of water, please follow these safety guidelines:

1. **SUPERVISE** – never leave a child unsupervised near a body of water. Young children should be kept within arms reach.
2. **SWIMMING** – teach your child how to swim by taking swimming lessons through a certified swimming organization.
3. **STAY IN DESIGNATED SWIM AREAS** – when at public beaches, swim only in areas set aside for swimming. Be aware of signs that may be posted about water conditions, such as currents and undertows.
4. **INSTALL A FENCE/ALARM** – if you own a pool, there should be a fence at least 4' tall around the pool, with a latching gate. Use an alarm that sends a alert when someone enters the pool.
5. **LEARN CPR** – all parents and child-care providers should know CPR and basic water rescue skills. The Jackson Fire Department holds CPR classes. Contact the Jackson Fire Department at 262-677-3811 for questions, information, or to sign up for a CPR class.

Brush Chipping and Yard Waste

During the summer months, brush chipping and bag pick-up will occur monthly on the third Monday of each month. The remaining dates are: July 19th, August 16th, and September 20th. Pick-up may also occur after a major storm. **Bags with only fresh grass clippings will be tagged and will not be picked up.** To drop off yard waste, yard waste site access cards are available Monday-Friday from 7:30 AM – 4:00 PM at the Public Works and Inspections building located at W194 N16660 Eagle Dr. Pick up a pass for site access seven (7) days a week.

The Village Board will be exploring options for developing the property adjacent to the municipal building in the near future.




20th ANNIVERSARY 9/11 SHIRTS


