POLLING LOCATION MOVES TO THE JACKSON AREA COMMUNITY CENTER FOR THE NOVEMBER 2020 GENERAL AND PRESIDENTIAL ELECTION

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Jackson Village Board approved a change in the polling location for the Tuesday, November 3, 2020 General and Presidential Election.

The election will be held at the Jackson Area Community Center located at N165 W20330 Hickory Lane (at the Northeast corner of Hickory Lane and Jackson Drive.)

IN-PERSON ABSENTEE VOTING BEGINS OCTOBER 20th — ENDS OCTOBER 30th AT THE JACKSON VILLAGE HALL WEEKDAYS FROM 8:00 A.M.—4:00 P.M.



VILLAGE OF JACKSON MUNICIPAL COMPLEX BEGINS TO TAKE SHAPE

Construction on the new Village of Jackson Municipal Complex has risen above the foundation level.

The complex is being constructed using masonry block walls and precast concrete wall panels.

Concurrent with the municipal complex are extensions of Ridgeway Drive and Spruce Street. The Ridgeway Drive extension north to STH 60

still awaits the approval of WisDOT.

Mike Koenig Construction is the general contractor and Cedar Corporation is the architect and engineering firm managing the project.

The municipal complex is scheduled to open in September of 2021.

JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT PRESCRIPTION DRUG TAKE BACK Saturday, October 24th, 9:00 a.m. to Noon

The Jackson Police Department, in cooperation with the Department of Justice (DOJ) and Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA), will participate in National Prescription Drug Take Back Day on Saturday, October 24th from 9:00 a.m. to Noon, outside the garage doors of the Police Department located at N168 W20733 Main Street. An officer will help you dispose of the acceptable items (see list below) – No Questions Asked.

BRING: Unused prescriptions (controlled and non-controlled) and over-the-counter medications, ointments, creams, vials, patches, non-aerosol sprays, inhalers, and pet medications.

DO NOT BRING: Illegal drugs, needles/sharps, acids, aerosol cans, bio-hazardous materials (anything containing blood or bodily fluids,) or personal care products (such as shampoo, soaps, lotions, or sunscreens), mercury thermometers, or household hazardous waste (such as paint, pesticides, oil, or gasoline).

Liquids will be accepted, however liquids, creams, or sprays must be in their original packaging or they will not be accepted.

Empty pill bottles will be defaced and donated to the Washington County Humane Society for their use with packaging pet medications.

AUTUMN CLEANUP DAY Saturday, October 17th 9:00 a.m. to Noon

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the April annual Village-Wide Spring Clean-up Day was canceled. A one-time-only AUTUMN Cleanup Day has been scheduled for Saturday, October 17th from 9:00 a.m. until Noon. Village residents may bring bags of leaves or yard waste and household waste (TVs, microwaves, furniture, computers, and metals) to the Street Department, located at W194 N16660 Eagle Drive (just south of Tennes Hardware.) Yard waste should be placed in biodegradable paper bags. Be prepared to show identification verifying Village of Jackson residency. **NO PAINTS, TIRES, BATTERIES, MAJOR APPLIANCES, FREON, OR CONSTRUCTION WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

Residents may register on that day for access cards to the new Yard Waste Site.

From the Desk of the Village President . . .

Great things are happening in the Village of Jackson!

With the upcoming elections less than a month away, it's important to address several issues. First, the Village Board voted to hold the November elections at the Jackson Area Community Center located at N165 W20330 Hickory Lane in the Village of Jackson, rather than at the Village Hall.

The major reason for the change of venue is that much more space is available at the Community Center, allowing for better social distancing inside and more parking outside.

Since many of our dedicated poll workers fall within the COVID-19 high-risk category, and since parking is often tight at the Village Hall, the change of venue was deemed appropriate. Please make a note of the change for election day voting on November 3rd.

Please see the Park and Recreation Department website for information on scheduling changes for activities normally held at the Community Center. You may visit the Village Hall at N168 W20733 Main Street in the Village of Jackson for in-person absentee voting prior to election day.

It's always important to have a pool of quality people willing and able to assist during elections. Individuals interested in serving as poll workers for future elections should contact the Village Clerk, Jilline Dobratz, at 262-677-9001 Ext. 11 for more information.

Village Administrator John Walther has announced his intention to retire in the near future. John has served as the administrator since 2008, and like most village employees, has served faithfully, keeping the best interests of the Village and its residents at the forefront of day-to-day operations.

The Village Board is working with a talent-location firm specializing in recruiting candidates for public positions to find a replacement administrator. We anticipate that the new administrator will begin early in the new year.

Work continues on the new municipal building, with walls going up now that the major underground work has been completed.

Thanks to all who think, work, and act to make the Village of Jackson a great place for all of us!

FALL SEASON BRUSH and BAG PICK-UP

Fall Season brush chipping and bag pick-up began Monday, October 5th and will continue each Monday through November 16th. **DO NOT** rake grass or deposit leaves or other yard waste into the street.

CAN WE FIND YOU IN AN EMERGENCY?

Every structure must have the address posted in a location that is fully visible from the street and is in contrast with the background.

Address numbers that are old, faded, non-reflective, obstructed by vegetation, architectural elements, or in an obscure area may delay an emergency response.

Please verify that your address numbers are displayed correctly. Replacement address numbers including individual tiles, full address sets, and brackets are available at the Public Works Building at W194 N16660 Eagle Drive.

WINTER PARKING RULES

Beginning December 1st, on-street parking will be prohibited from 2:00—6:00 a.m. in order to facilitate rapid and economical snow removal.

The seasonal parking ban ends April 1st. If you have a question about parking, call the Jackson Police Department on their non-emergency line at 262-677-4949.
