JACKSON ELEMENTARY 4 & 5 YEAR OLD KINDER- GARTEN ENROLLMENT

Jackson Elementary School Four and Five Year Old Kindergarten Enrollment is coming up!

Bring a birth certificate for your child and proof of residency on these days to enroll: Tuesday, January 30th from 8:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. at Jackson Elementary; Wednesday, January 30th from 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. at Jackson Elementary; and from 4:00 p.m. - 8:00 p.m. at the West Bend School District Office at 735 S Main Street in West Bend.

FROM THE JACKSON POLICE DEPARTMENT REGARDING SNOW AND ICE REMOVAL FROM SIDEWALKS

Per Village of Jackson Code of Ordinances, sidewalks are to be cleared of snow and ice within twenty-four hours of the end of a snowfall. This protects pedestrians and also reduces the liability of property owners and the Village for injuries incurred on slippery walks.

Remember also, that you may not blow or deposit snow onto Village streets.

DOG/CAT LICENSES

Licenses for dogs and cats are required in the Village of Jackson by **March 31, 2018. No more than**



two (2) dogs and two (2) cats may be licensed for any one residence. Exceptions

may be requested by application to the Plan Commission and Village Board for a Conditional Use permit or Planned Unit Development Amendment.

ADOPT-A-HYDRANT

Having to search for that fire hydrant buried in snow can take precious time away from fighting the fire.

FROM THE STREET DEPARTMENT

Please place your discarded Christmas trees at the curb for pickup. Please discard your wreaths in your garbage container (as evergreen wreaths have wire rings and will damage the Village's chipper.)

PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS

For property owners who have not yet paid their 2017 property taxes, the first installment must be paid to the Village of Jackson Treasurer on or before January 31, 2018 (Mailing Address: Village of Jackson Treasurer, PO Box 637, Jackson, WI 53037.) Remember to include the payment stub with your first installment payment.

If you would like a receipt, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

The second installment must be paid to the Washington County Treasurer on or before July 31, 2018 (Address: Washington County Treasurer, 432 E Washington St, PO Box 1986, West Bend, WI 53095.) Remember to include the payment stub with your installment payment.

JANUARY IS NATIONAL RADON ACTION MONTH FREE RADON TEST KITS AVAILABLE NOW

The Washington County Health Department is encouraging citizens to test their homes for radon this winter. The Health Department is offering free radon test kits (one per household) while supplies last. The Washington County office is open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and is located at 333 E Washington St, Suite 1100, PO Box 2003, West Bend, WI 53095-2003. If you wish to have a kit mailed to you, send the Health Department a check for \$4.00 with your name and address, and a kit will be mailed to your home.

You may be surprised to know that radon is the second leading cause of lung cancer, causing an estimated 20,000 lung cancer deaths per year in the United States. By taking action now to pre-

vent exposure to harmful radon gas, you can help assure your future health. Each building is unique, so testing is the only way to know if you have high levels of radon in your home. Paula Mugan, the Washington County Health Department Environmental Health Supervisor states, "Everyone should test their home for radon. If the radon level is high, a radon mitigation system should be installed by a certified radon mitigation contractor."

As 2018 opens, and we look forward to the year ahead, it's appropriate to thank the people who served the Village so well during the last year and whose service and assistance we count on in the coming year.

To all the great people who serve in Administration, Building Inspection, the Fire Department, Parks and Recreation, the Police Department, the Public Works Department, Waste Water Treatment, and the Water Utility, we thank you for your service and dedication to the people of the Village of Jackson.

This year's spring election will be held on April 3, 2018.

Keith Berben, John Kruepke, Debbie Kurtz, and Gary Malcolm have each filed papers to run for the three positions on the Village Board that will be up for election this spring. Thanks to each of these individuals for their interest and willingness to serve the community. Although it has not yet been confirmed, in the past the Greater Jackson Business Alliance has hosted an open forum where citizens can hear each of the candidates express their point of view on topics of importance to Village residents.

Trustee Mike Kufahl filed papers in December indicating that he will not be running for another term on the Village Board. We thank him for his many years of service and dedication on the Board of Trustees and on the various commissions, boards, and committees he has served on in the past.

Thanks also to Greg Winn for his service on the Plan Commission. Greg served on the Plan Commission for several years until he and his family relocated outside the Village of Jackson. At the January Village Board meeting, John Weil will be nominated to serve out the remainder of the term vacated by Greg Winn.

The Joint Board of Review and Village Board have approved the creation of a Tax Increment District for the development of property east of County Trunk Highway P north of Rosewood Lane. A new consortium has come forward with plans to acquire and improve the property that had been slated for development nearly twenty years ago. We look forward to seeing what develops to further enhance the Village of Jackson.

The Friends of Jackson Parks and Recreation organization continues its efforts to raise funds for an all-inclusive playground at Hickory Lane Park. Thanks to their hard work and the generous people and businesses of Jackson, nearly \$85,000.00 has been raised for the project to date.
