The annual Village Spring Clean-up Day is set for Saturday, April 29th, from 9:00 a.m. until Noon. Village residents will be able to bring bags of leaves or yard waste and household waste (TVs, microwaves, furniture, computers, and metals) to the Street Department, located at W204 N16690 Jackson Drive. Yard waste should be placed in a biodegradable paper bag. This will be the last Spring Clean-Up at the Jackson Drive location. Next year will be at the new location on Eagle Drive.

Please be prepared to show identification to verify Village of Jackson residency.

NO PAINTS, TIRES, BATTERIES, MAJOR APPLIANCES, FREON, OR CONSTRUCTION WASTE WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Great things are happening in the Village of Jackson!

Reconstruction of Chateau Drive is underway. Along with the replacement of the street surface, this project includes the replacement of water mains, storm water and wastewater piping, and upgrades to natural gas and electrical utilities as needed. This work is scheduled to be complete very early to comply with the requirements to receive state grant funds.

At its March meeting, the Village Board approved the concept plan for new all-inclusive playground equipment for Hickory Lane Park. The tropical-themed surfaces and structures will fit nicely with the splash pad. Tentatively scheduled for installation in 2018, it's hoped the project will be mainly funded by park impact fees and funds raised by the non-profit "Friends of Jackson Joint Parks and Recreation" organization, supplemented with Village of Jackson general fund dollars. Thanks to the Friends group for their commitment and dedication to maintaining and improving great parks in the Village of Jackson. Please support their fundraising efforts generously. Thanks also to Kelly Valentino and the Recreation Department staff for their inspiration and work in putting together the plan for what promises to be a great addition to Hickory Lane Park! One of the great things about the Jackson community is the high number of people with positive moral values and an interest in doing what's right.

On the afternoon of April 30, Jackson resident Cheryl Gelhar will host the founder of the LOVE>hate Project, Dr. Buck Blodgett, at Coffeetown on Main Street.
