2024 Pet Licensing Information

All dogs and cats five (5) months of age or older must be licensed by January 1, 2024. Rabies vaccine certificates are required before a license may be issued. There will be a \$10.00 late fee for each pet not licensed by March 31st, 2024.

The Jackson Water Utility will be flushing the entire water system during the week of Monday, April 15th to Friday, April 19th, between the hours of 7:00AM—4:00PM.

Flushing is performed to improve the quality of your water service. You may experience a temporary interruption in service. If your service is off for more than 30 minutes, please call the Utility office at 262-677-0707.

Fire Prevention Update

October was fire prevention month. The Jackson Fire Department was fortunate enough to visit seven schools and conduct 14 presentations about fire safety to over 635 children within our community! Along with the school visits, the JFD hosted its annual Open House on October 11th. Fire Safety is important to keep in mind all year. Remember to have your chimney and furnace professionally inspected and cleaned, do not overload extension cords, keep electric heaters away from combustible materials and never leave them unattended.

2024 Main Street Resurface Project

The project will be bid in January 2024 and awarded by the WisDOT. Resurfacing work to commence between Eagle Dr. and CTH P in March of 2024. There will be a single lane of eastbound traffic maintained for most of the project, with the exception during railroad crossing work. Westbound will be detoured with routes to be announced. Spring Clean-Up

The Annual Village of Jackson Spring Clean-up Day will be Saturday, April 27th, from 9:00AM until noon. Village residents may bring household waste (TV's, microwaves, furniture, computers and metals) and yard waste to the Street Department, located at W194N16660 Eagle Drive. Yard waste should be placed in biodegradable paper bags. Be prepared to show proof of Village of Jackson residency. No paint, tires, batteries, major appliances, freon or construction waste.

Radon Test Kits

Keep Sidewalks Clear

Failure to maintain sidewalks in a clear and safe manner may result in the issuance of a municipal citation. Sidewalks must be cleared within 24 hours after snow or ice ceases to fall.

The West Bend School District/Jackson Parks & Recreation 4K Enrollment for 2024-25 Begins January 29, 2024

The West Bend School District community-based 4K Program is an optional program offered at no cost to families who live in the West Bend School District (WBSD) attendance area. The Jackson Parks & Recreation Department is a 4K partner that offers the 4K and supported 3K at the Jackson Community Center. The program is taught by certified teachers that use play to promote early reading, math skills, language development, and social/emotional growth through play. Children in the WBSD who are at least four years of age on or before September 1, 2024 are eligible to enroll in the WBSD 4K program. Enrollment will start on January 29, 2024 and will only be online. Germantown, Slinger, and Cedarburg School District children may be eligible to open enroll into a Jackson 4K site, complete the open enrollment forms on the WBSD site. There will be a Virtual WBSD 4K Informational Parent Meeting Wednesday, January 17 at 6pm.
