
STH 60 /Eagle Dr. Project

Resurfacing of STH60, from Hwy P to Eagle Drive, and roundabout project at Eagle Drive begins mid-April. One lane of traffic (eastbound only) will be maintained throughout the project, with the exception of a one week time period, late May, when the railroad crossing replacement will occur and close the road. Westbound traffic will be detoured along County G, County NN and County P starting mid-April. County P will be closed south of WIS 60 beginning June 3rd. STH 60 work is scheduled to conclude August 23rd.

Licensing Season is Approaching

Alcohol, operators (bartenders), cigarette/tobacco licenses, hotel/motel, and tattoo/body piercing establishment and operators licenses expire annually on June 30th. For those with current licenses, watch your mail for relicensing information. A recent law change at the State level also requires municipal licenses for those selling electronic vaping products. Got Weeds?

Weeds, overgrown grass, and other vegetation are a common property maintenance complaint. Weeds in sidewalks and other hard-surface areas can also present trip hazards as well as cause decay and deterioration of the material. Please mow your lawn regularly.

Brush Chipping and Yard Waste

Brush chipping and bag pick-up will begin Monday, April 29th, and continue each Monday until May 28th (Tuesday after Memorial Day). During the summer months, brush chipping and bag pick-up will occur monthly on the third Monday of each month. The dates are: June 17th, July 15th, August 19th, and September 16th. Pick-up may also occur after a major storm. Bags with only grass clippings will be tagged and will not be picked up. To drop off yard waste, yard waste site access cards are available Monday-Friday from 7:30 AM – 4 PM at the Public Works building, located at W194N16660 Eagle Drive. Passes allow for site access seven days a week.

Water Main Flushing April 15th—April 19th

The Jackson Water Utility will begin flushing water mains throughout the water service area Monday, April 15th, through Friday, April 19th, between 7 AM and 4 PM. Semi-annual water main flushing is performed to improve the quality of your water service.

You may experience a brief interruption in service. If your water service remains off for more than 30 minutes, call the Water Utility Clerk at 262-677-0707. Run the cold water before you wash clothes or dishes. If discoloration is experienced in the cold water, let it run until it clears.

Grass Fire Season—What to Know

When we think of spring, we think about “April showers” and “May flowers,” with lots of wet soil and mud, due to melting snow. However, it is not what is near the ground that poses a risk, it is what is on top, which is dry, brittle leaves, twigs, and brush from the previous fall. It is these materials that are so easily ignitable.

You can help prevent a grass fire by:

- Extinguish cigarettes and dispose of properly.
- Do not park vehicles on dry grass or shrubs.
- Trim low hanging tree branches and rake up dead grass and leaves.
- Use grills on hard flat surfaces, away from grass, shrubs, and homes.
- Be extra cautious if burning on your property.
