State and County Road Project Updates

Main Street Resurfacing and Eagle Drive Roundabout

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation has shared the following information with the Village:

July construction will include curb, gutter, and curb ramp improvements at intersections. Paving from CTH P to Eagle Drive Roundabout paving will occur in July. Lastly, underground construction for all signal improvements will be completed.

In July, traffic will remain eastbound only in the north lane on Main Street. Traffic will be allowed in both directions (east and west) from CTH P to Jackson Drive in early August.

CTH P Construction

The Washington County Highway Department has shared the following information with the Village: CTH P is closed from STH 145 to STH 60 (Main Street) and open to local traffic only. A detour route is posted utilizing STH 145, USH 45 and STH 60. At this time, crews north of Sherman Road are ditching, installing storm sewer and driveways. South of Sherman Road, crews are working on ditching, road subgrade, and working on the Polk Springs box culvert. Project completion is anticipated October 2024.

Summer Safety Awareness

Stay hydrated - Have water available when out in the sun. Begin your day with a tall glass of water and, when working in the heat, drink one glass of water every 15-20 minutes to stay hydrated. Limit consumption of sports drinks as these contain high levels of caffeine and sugar.

Heat – Know the signs of heat exhaustion: heavy sweating, muscle cramps, dizziness, headache and nausea/vomiting. Take frequent breaks, either in the shade, resting in air conditioning, or with a fan.

Swimming – Always maintain adult supervision. A child can drown in less than 20 seconds! Visit pools with lifeguards on staff. Wear a U.S. Coast Guard flotation device for those who cannot swim.

Boating – Take the Boaters Safety course. Be sure there is a properly fitting life-vest for each person on board. Be cognizant of the weather, as it can change at any time. Have a working fire extinguisher and an emergency/first-aid kit on board. Do not drink and drive.

Burning – Burn only in designated fire pits/rings. Keep children at least three feet away from fire! Never leave a fire unattended and be sure the fire is completely extinguished prior to leaving. When burning brush/yard waste, contact the non-emergency Jackson Fire Department number at 262-677-3811 to learn the burning rules in your area.

Please visit the Building Inspection Department located at W194 N16660 Eagle Drive, 7:30 AM—4 PM. The office is open weekdays excluding holidays. The dropbox is available for after-hours submittals.

If you have recently completed a project, such as remodeling, HVAC replacement, electrical service upgrades, built a shed or fence, replacement of windows/roof/siding, or any other project that may have required a permit, a Final Inspection is required. 



