Voting in the Village of Jackson

The Spring Election is on April 1, 2025, and, if needed, the Spring Primary is on February 18, 2025. Both take place at the Jackson Municipal Complex located at N168W19851 Main Street from 7AM-8PM. Please visit the official Wisconsin election website at myvote.wi.gov to do any of the following:



- Register to Vote
- Update your name and/or address
- See what's on your ballot
- Find your polling location
- Locate your municipal clerk
- Request an Absentee Ballot

For information on Registering to Vote, Proof of Residency, Photo Identification, and more, visit the Wisconsin Elections Commission Website at elections.wi.gov/voters. 2025 Pet Licensing Information

2024 Pet licenses expired December 31st. Dogs and cats age five (5) months or older must be licensed in the Village of Jackson. 2025 tags are currently available at the Administration Office during regular business hours. A rabies vaccination report for each pet must be presented at the time of licensing, and you must include a self-addressed stamped envelope if you would like your tags mailed to you. 2025 Pet licensing fees:

Dogs: \$10 Spayed/Neutered \$15-Unaltered
Cats: \$7 Spayed/Neutered \$10-Unaltered

Chloride Alert

Jackson Sewer Utility is asking for your help to reduce the amount of chloride released into Cedar Creek. Two main factors that influence chlorides in water coming to the Wastewater Treatment Plant are water softener brine tank regeneration and de-icing of public and private sidewalks, driveways, parking lots and roads. If your water softener regenerates on a timer, consider switching to a high efficiency softener that regenerates with a meter. Metered water softeners track the amount of water used and regenerate only when needed. Help us reduce the amount of chloride entering the Wastewater Treatment Facility by reducing the rate of salt used by water softeners. Your efforts will aid in collectively reducing the release of chloride to our environment. Call us with questions at 262-677-0707 ext. 610.

Spring Clean-Up

The Annual Village of Jackson Spring Clean-up Day is Saturday, April 26th, 9AM-Noon. Village residents may bring household waste (TV's, microwaves, furniture, computers and metals) and yard waste to the Street Department, located at W194N16660 Eagle Drive. Yard waste must be placed in biodegradable paper bags. Be prepared to show proof of residency in the Village of Jackson. No paint, tires, batteries, major appliances, freon or construction waste will be accepted.

Water Main Flushing April 21st–25th

The Jackson Water Utility will be flushing the entire water system 7AM-4PM during the week of Monday, April 21st through Friday, April 25th. Flushing improves the quality of your water service. Please note a temporary disruption of service may occur. Call the Utility office at 262-677-0707 if your water is off longer than 30 minutes. It may be necessary to run water in a tub or sink until water runs clear after flushing.

Keep Sidewalks Clear

Property owners must keep all public sidewalks clear of snow and ice, along the full width and length of the sidewalk. Sidewalks must be cleared within 24 hours after snow or ice ceases to fall. Failure to maintain sidewalks in a clear and safe manner may result in a municipal citation. Fire hydrants should also be cleared of snow for easy access by the fire department.

Heater Safety

Heating equipment is the leading cause of fires in U.S. homes. Each year, fire departments respond to over 52,000 fires involving heating equipment, which includes wood-burning fireplaces, ovens and space-heaters. Reports indicate that more than 1/2 of all home heating fires occur in the months of December, January, and February. Some safety tips to consider are:

- Keep combustibles at least three (3) feet away from heating equipment
- Never use the oven or stove to heat your home
- Do not use grills intended for outdoor use or kerosene/propane heaters inside your home
- Have heating equipment and chimneys professionally cleaned and inspected each year
- Do not leave space heaters unattended
