Any future amendments, revisions, or modifications of the statutes incorporated in this section are intended to be made part of this section.

**WHEREAS**, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and posting or publication as provided by law.

**WHEREAS**, if any section or portion thereof shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful, or unenforceable, such decision shall apply only to the specific section or portion thereof directly specified in the decision and shall not affect the validity of any other provisions, sections, or portions thereof of the ordinance. The remainder of the ordinance

shall remain in full force and effect. Any other ordinances whose terms are in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed as to those terms that conflict.






