

RESOLUTION #24-36

A RESOLUTION OBLIGATING REMAINING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDS

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021 the President of the United States signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) to provide continued relief from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the ARPA program appropriates funds to assist state, local, tribal and territory governments in responding to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson has been notified of ARPA funding in the amount of \$753,613.60, payable in two tranches; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Jackson is in receipt of the first tranche in the amount of \$376,806.80 on June 25, 2021, and the second tranche in the amount of \$376,806.80 on June 21, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Treasury has issued final guidance on how the Village can utilize the funding, with funds having to be obligated by the end of 2024 and spent by the end of 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Treasury presumes that up to \$10 million in revenue has been lost due to the public health emergency and recipients are permitted to use that amount (not to exceed the award amount) to fund "government services."; and

WHEREAS, Recipients may elect a "standard allowance" of \$10 million to spend on government services through the period of performance; and

WHEREAS, All recipients may elect to use this standard allowance instead of calculating lost revenue using the formula provided by US Treasury, including those with total allocations of \$10 million or less; and

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2022 the Village of Jackson Village Board approved Resolution #22-12 authorizing the use of ARPA funds for expenses related to the installation of fiber internet to three (3) public buildings in the amount of \$99,643.20.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Village Board of the Village of Jackson, Washington County, Wisconsin, does hereby obligate and authorize the expenditures of the remaining ARPA funds in the amount of \$653,970.40 for the following projects:

- Knight Barry Title Service in the amount of \$171,710.38 for the purchase of Land to be later added to Hasmer Lake Park.
- TreeTop Products in the amount of \$5,043.51 for the purchase of Hickory Lane Park path benches and recycling containers.
- Miller-Bradford & Risberg Inc. in the amount of \$100,000.00 for the purchase of a John Deere snowblower.
- Miller-Bradford & Risberg Inc. in the amount of \$130,314.00 for the purchase of a John Deere front end loader.
- Pro2Pave in the amount of \$143,952.00 for the Hickory Lane Park path project.
- Lakeside International in the amount of \$102,950.51 for the purchase of a snowplow.

Village staff, together with the Village Administrator, are hereby authorized to report use of ARPA funds as designated above to the United States Department of the Treasury.
