

Public Involvement Meeting Notice

The Village of Jackson will host a public involvement meeting to present proposed improvements for the following project:

2026 Street Improvements

**Eagle Drive, Hawthorn Drive, Aspen Drive, and Linden Drive
Village of Jackson**

Project Description

Eagle Drive will be reconstructed from approximately 350-feet north of Hickory Lane to STH 60. The proposed roadway cross section is urban, including curb and gutter, and sidewalk on one side of the street. Additional improvements include installing storm sewer and Village-owned street lighting and reconstructing the Village of Jackson Department of Public Works north parking lot.

Hawthorn Drive, Aspen Drive, and Linden Drive will be reconstructed from Hickory Lane to the north limits. The proposed roadway cross section for these 3 streets will match the existing widths. Sidewalks will be reconstructed to the Village standard width of 5-feet and will wrap around the outside of the cul-de-sac at the north end of each street to provide a continuous pedestrian path. Additional improvements include installing storm sewer, sump pump laterals, and Village-owned street lighting, reconstructing sanitary sewer manholes, and replacing water service curb boxes.

The purpose of the project is to address deteriorating pavement, improve the storm sewer system, improve pedestrian safety, and urbanize Eagle Drive.

Construction is scheduled to begin Spring 2026 and is scheduled to be completed by September 7th, 2026 (Labor Day).
