

**ORDINANCE #22-01**

---

**AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF VILLAGE CODE REGARDING JOINT VILLAGE AND TOWN PARKS AND RECREATION COMMITTEE**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board and Town of Jackson approved the Release, Settlement and Termination Agreement on December 9<sup>th</sup>; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement included the dissolution of the Joint Village and Town Parks and Recreation Committee as established in the Development and Operations Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village must amend language in Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 3, Sec. 2-186 "Joint Village and Town Parks and Recreation Committee";

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Village of Jackson Village Board, Washington County Wisconsin ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**Section I.** Repealing Chapter 2, Article IV, Division 3, Sec. 2-186 "Joint Village and Town Parks and Recreation Committee" and replacing with the following language:

Sec. 2-186. - Parks & Recreation Commission

(a)Purpose. The purpose of the commission is to provide assistance in the development, acquisition and maintenance of village parks, recreation and opens spaces. In addition, to provide direction and recommendations as related to annual budgets, policies, program & event continuity, the PROSP (Parks, Recreation & Open Space Plan) as required by the DNR and other duties as set forth in Wis. Stats. §27.08 as they apply.

(b)Membership. The commission shall consist of 5 members appointed by the village president. One member shall be a village board member and four citizen members. Appointments are made by the village president, subject to confirmation by the village board at the organizational meeting in April of each year or any other time if a vacancy occurs. Citizen members shall have staggered (3) year terms. The Commission Chairman will be selected by the Commission.

(c)Meetings. Generally, the Parks & Recreation Commission meets the third Tuesday of the month, as needed.

**Section II.** This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and posting.
