

ORDINANCE #21-02

AMENDING CHAPTER 18 OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING THE SALE, POSSESSION, AND USE OF FIREWORKS

THE VILLAGE BOARD OF THE VILLAGE OF JACKSON, WASHINGTON COUNTY, WISCONSIN, does hereby ordain the following changes to the Village Code:

Section 18-96 of the Village Code of the Village of Jackson is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 18-96. - Fireworks

- (a) Prohibition on Sale of Fireworks. No person may sell fireworks within the Village of Jackson.
- (b) Use and Possession of Fireworks. No person may use or possess fireworks within the Village of Jackson without a permit approved for issuance by the Village Fire and Police Departments.
- (c) "Fireworks" Defined. For purposes of this Section, "fireworks" shall be defined as provided in Wis. Stat. § 167.10(1)
- (d) Authorized Possession and Use of Fireworks. Notwithstanding the foregoing, fireworks may be possessed and used in the manner authorized by Wis. Stat. § 167.10(3)(b), as amended.

Section 28-5(6) of the Village Code of the Village of Jackson is hereby amended to read:

Sec. 28-5. – Specific acts and conditions deemed nuisances affecting peace and safety.

- (6) All possession or use of fireworks except as provided by state law and village ordinances.

All other provisions of the Village of Jackson Code of Ordinances remain in full force and effect.

All relevant Village officials are hereby authorized and directed to take all action necessary to implement this Ordinance.
