

Official Ballot Presidential Preference Vote Nonpartisan Office and Referendum April 2, 2024

Notice to voters: if you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two (2) election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials (see end of ballot for initials).

If you do not choose a party, and you vote in more than one party, no votes will be counted. <p>Special Instructions for Presidential Preference Vote</p> <p>Choose the party in which you will vote. Within the party you have chosen, you have ONE of 3 choices:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Vote for a candidate whose name is printed on this ballot in the party you have chosen. Vote for an uninstructed delegation from Wisconsin to the national convention of the party you have chosen.
